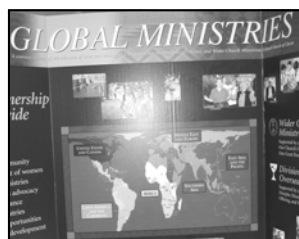


Participants expressed appreciation for the contemplative space of the **Taize Healing Eucharist** and the innocent voices of children reading passages.
