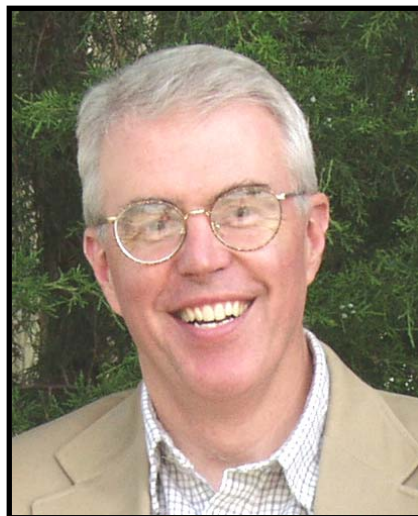

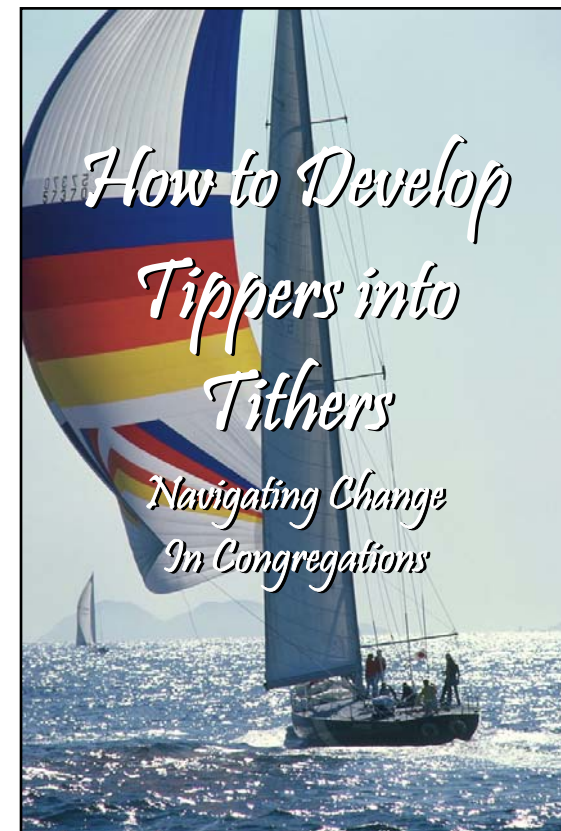

This talking and teaching workshop is for church teams (pastor and at least 3 members of a team with an emphasis on stewardship) and will cover:

- Principles in Giving
- Re-thinking Motives for Giving
- Re-thinking the Stewardship Letter
- Helping People Grow their Giving

At the end of the day each team will return home with an organized strategy for their year-round stewardship effort.

Please come with a chart of your church's giving pattern for the last 3-5 years. The chart will list levels of giving (e.g. less than \$500, \$500-\$749, \$750-\$999, \$1,000-\$1,499, etc.) and how many givers made contributions for the year at each level. Doing this exercise for 3 years or more (with a chart for each year) provides critical information and will help you benefit more from the workshop.

Your Church Team: Finance Committee members, money counters, Stewardship Committee members, the pastor, and any other people in the church who are enthusiastic about the mission of the church and good at communication.

Cost: \$175 per church which includes all materials and lunch. Bring as many folks as you can recruit. Partial scholarships are available for small churches.

Early registration is \$135 per church prior to March 1.
